

NOTICE OF POSSIBLE INSURANCE DENIAL

Insurance companies typically only pay for services that they determine to be “Reasonable and Necessary.” If your insurance company determines that a particular item is “Not Reasonable and Necessary” then they will deny payment for the item.

In addition, if the insurance company refuses payment even after issuing an authorization, if the insurance company does not pay after a reasonable amount of time (typically 90 days) or if there is an applicable deductible, co-insurance or co-pay, the patient is responsible for the charges.
